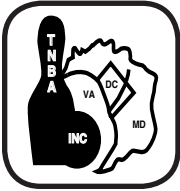

GWBS TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament shall be certified and open to all adult members of TNBA and USBC. The tournament shall operate under the rules of TNBA and USBC.
2. Non-USBC members may enter by paying an associate membership fee of \$21.00. **Non-TNBA members may enter by paying a \$15.00 membership fee. If you cannot show proof of these membership cards, you must purchase a membership card at the tournament site. A \$5.00 service fee will be assessed for processing membership cards at the tournament site.**
3. The tournament shall commence on Saturday, January 9, 2010 and run for four (4) consecutive weekends ending Sunday, January 31, 2010. Squads will begin at 10:00am on January 9, 2010 and end at 4:00pm on January 31, 2010. Monday, January 18, 2010, squad times 12:00 noon & 2:00pm.
4. A minimum of two (2) teams will constitute a squad. A minimum of six (6) teams will constitute a squad for any 6:00pm squad added by the tournament manager.
5. All entrants must use the highest USBC 2008-09 season book average with a minimum of **36** games. If no book average, use highest current USBC certified average based on a minimum of **36** games as of the date of participation in this tournament. Participants without book averages, must present a current league standing sheet, **for 36 games or more at the time of bowling**, to the tournament director. **Average book considered official for all other average verifications. The ten pin rule does NOT apply. If you do not have any of these averages, you must bowl with a 220 average. NO EXCEPTIONS. No summer league averages accepted.**
6. **USBC participants are cautioned to be familiar with the USBC average adjustment rules 319c and 319e.**
7. **It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, including number of games, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his/her partner, or others.** Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if the submitted average is lower than the correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the average submitted to the tournament if it is higher than the correct average. **There will be no return of funds on disqualifications.**
8. **If your team bowls a score of 1375 or higher, or you bowl a singles score of 700 or higher, you must fill out an average verification form.**
9. Handicap will be 100% of 220 for men and women.
10. All teams will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes with total pins plus handicap deciding the tournament winner.
11. Re-entries are permitted. Bowl as often as you wish, but you may **cash only once with the same partner**. Change partners and cash again. **Cash only once in singles.**
12. Prize fee will be returned 100%. Prize ratio will be one (1) for every ten (10) entries.
13. **It is the bowler's responsibility to turn in the official RECAP sheet upon completion of bowling. If no recap sheet is turned in, the bowlers will receive zeros for their scores. Failure to submit a recap sheet after bowling forfeits all rights to entry fees and prizes the bowler may have won.**
14. The decision of the Tournament Manager shall be final on any and all disputes, unless an appeal is made.
15. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to disqualify any entrant not in compliance with the rules of TNBA and USBC.
16. Entrants must pay their entry fee (\$56.00 per team) before beginning competition. Any bowler who issues a non-negotiable check will not be eligible for future participation in the tournament until reimbursement, plus \$40.00 handling fee per check, is paid in full and thereafter, must pay in cash. If the check is not paid within 10 days from the date the bowler is notified, his/her name will be submitted to TNBA and USBC for **suspension**.
17. A bowler who has qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$600 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous 12 month period must report actual score, position and amount won to the tournament management at time of bowling for possible rerating. Failure to comply shall be cause to forfeit tournament entry fee and prize winnings. **See USBC rule 319d.**
18. No entries will be accepted after 3:45pm on the last day of the tournament, January 31, 2010.
19. All other TNBA and USBC rules will apply.

NOTE: Bowlers have until completion of the first game to correct their averages.
