ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates must be a member of TNBA, a youth bowling program in the Washington Metropolitan area or a member of a collegiate bowling program, or their parents/legal guardians are members of TNBA.
- Candidates must be a graduating high school senior, an undergraduate student or attending a vocational/technical institution.
- Candidates must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA or equivalent.
- Candidates must attend and/or have been accepted to attend an accredited college, university or vocational institution in the United States or Canada.

NOTES

- TNBA plans to award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships: one male and one female youth member will be selected for the scholarship. This is based on the applications the committee receives by the due date. The recipients will receive an initial award and may reapply for the scholarship.
- The deadline for the **POSTMARK** of your application is **MAY 30, 2024**. Regardless of when an application is postmarked, it will not be considered if it arrives after June 15, 2024.



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INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Complete all questions. Please submit the entire application in typed format. Any item(s) left blank will result in the application not being further considered. Also, "N/A" is not considered an acceptable answer. "None" or "Zero" may be used where appropriate.
- 2. Submit all items shown under the "Application Submission Requirements" section together in one envelope in the order listed. If an item is received by itself, your application will be discarded. Incomplete packages will not be considered.
- 3. Please do not staple your application submission, clip materials together. Remove your transcripts from the separate envelope and clip as the last item in your package of materials. The only item which requires a staple is your photograph which is to be placed in the upper right-hand corner of your completed application.
- 4. Only mailed applications with the required attachments will be considered for the scholarship.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Candidate's photograph (This photograph will be included in media and printed materials by GWBS.)
- 2. Completed application.
- 3. Youth league official standing sheet and official documentation verifying games bowled and average.
- 4. Typed essay—A 150-word brief statement in typed, double spaced format.
- 5. Reference letter(s). No more than two (2) letters.
- 6. Copy of transcript that includes GPA score.

Applications must be received by **MAY 30, 2024** to be considered. Applications will accepted by mail and email. Please include all the required information to ensure processing of your application by the committee. ESSAY REQUIREMENTS: Write a brief essay (1-2 pages) about an activity that was a personal priority and improved your school or the community in general. Choose something that reflects your values and state why you think it is important. Keep in mind that this is only component of the application that allows you to tell the selection committee something about yourself; creative responses are encouraged. Please submit in typed, double spaced format.

REFERENCE REQUIREMENTS: Please provide the committee with a single reference from someone who is familiar with your goals and attributes. Consider asking a current or former teacher, coach, employer, principal, clergy member, volunteer supervisor, neighbor, or family friend. References from guidance counselors are not encouraged unless you have a unique relationship. Avoid reference letters that are too vague, generic, or written for a purpose other than securing this scholarship.
