GWBS TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. The tournament shall commence on Saturday, January 3, 2026, and run for four (4) consecutive weekends ending Sunday, January 25, 2026. Squads will start 1 pm January 3, 2026, with final squad at 3:30pm on January 25, 2026. Additional squads on MLK Day, Monday, January 19, 2026, squad times 12:00 noon and 2:00pm.
- 2. A minimum of eight (8) teams will constitute a squad.
- 3. This tournament shall be certified and open to all adult members of TNBA and USBC. All USBC rules will be enforced. The tournament shall operate under the rules of TNBA and USBC. PBA/PWBA MEMBERS OF ANY DIVISION ARE NOT PERMITTED TO BOWL IN THIS TOURNAMENT.
- 4. NON-TNBA MEMBERS MAY ENTER BY PAYING A \$30.00 MEMBERSHIP FEE. NON-USBC MEMBERS MAY ENTER BY PAYING AN ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP FEE OF \$28.00. IF YOU CANNOT SHOW PROOF OF THESE MEMBERSHIP CARDS, YOU MUST PURCHASE A MEMBERSHIP CARD AT THE TOURNAMENT SITE.
- 5. All entrants must use the highest USBC 2024-25 season average, as indicated on Bowl.com or highest current average with a minimum of 21 games. MAXIMUM HANDICAP IS BASED ON A 120 AVERAGE. (Averages for entrants with sports averages ONLY will be adjusted using USBC sports average adjustment scale. PARTICIPANTS WITHOUT A USBC AVERAGE, MUST PRESENT A HARD COPY OF MOST RECENT HIGHEST AVERAGE LEAGUE STANDING SHEET, FOR 21 GAMES OR MORE
- 6. WITH THE ENTRY FORM OR 48 HOURS AFTER ENTRY. Bowl.com or current league sheet considered official for all average verifications. Summer averages are not accepted. If you do not have any of these averages, you must bowl with a 220 average. NO EXCEPTIONS. THE TEN PIN RULE DOES APPLY. All optional senior singles entrants must be at least 55 years of age at time of bowling.
- 7. Bowlers are cautioned to be familiar with USBC average adjustment rules 319c and 319e regarding average adjustments/re-rate.
- 8. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to disqualify any entrant AT ANY TIME not in compliance with GWBS tournament, USBC or TNBA rules.
- 9. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, including number of games (on initial entry and re-entry form) whether originally submitted by the bowler, his/her partner, or others. Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify scores if the submitted average is lower than the correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the average submitted to the tournament if it is higher than the correct average. THERE WILL BE NO RETURN OF FUNDS ON DISQUALIFICATIONS.
- 10. A bowler who has qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize of \$300 or more in a single event or in excess of \$500 in a tournament or total combined prize winnings of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the previous 12-month period must report actual score, position and amount won, to the tournament management PRIOR TO BOWLING FOR POSSIBLE RERATING. Failure to comply shall cause an average adjustment, or forfeit tournament entry fee and prize winnings.
- 11. Handicap will be 100% of 220 for men and women.
- 12. All teams will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes with total pins plus handicap deciding the doubles and singles handicap tournament winners. Total pins only will decide the scratch doubles and singles winners.
- 13. Re-entries are permitted. Bowl doubles as often as you wish, but you may CASH ONLY ONCE WITH THE SAME PARTNER.
- 14. Prize fee will be returned 100%. Prize ratio will be one (1) for every ten (10) entries.
- 15. IT IS THE BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO TURN IN THE OFFICIAL RECAP SHEET UPON COMPLETION OF BOWLING. IF NO RECAP SHEET IS TURNED IN, THE BOWLERS WILL RECEIVE ZEROES FOR THEIR SCORES. FAILURE TO SUBMIT A RECAP SHEET AFTER BOWLING FORFEITS ALL RIGHTS TO ENTRY FEES AND PRIZES THE BOWLER MAY HAVE WON.
- 16. Entrants must pay all entry fees at registration, prior to beginning competition. Any bowler who issues a non-negotiable check will not be eligible for future participation in the tournament until reimbursement, plus \$40.00 handling fee per check, is paid in full and thereafter, must pay in cash.
- 17. If the check is not paid within 10 days from the date the bowler is notified, his/her name will be submitted to TNBA and USBC for SUSPENSION.
- 18. No entries will be accepted after 3:30pm on the last day of the tournament, January 25, 2026.
- 19. All other TNBA and USBC rules will apply.
- 20. The decision of the Tournament Manager shall be final on any disputes unless an appeal is made.
